Parenting Tip of the Month:**'Connection Before Correction...'**

In the foundational years, big emotions often lead to big reactions. When your child has a meltdown or makes a mistake, it is tempting to immediately jump into 'fixing' or correcting the behavior. This month, try the 'Connection Before Correction' approach.

Before addressing what, they did wrong, acknowledge how they are feeling. A simple, 'I can see you are feeling very frustrated right now because your tower fell,' validates their emotions and calms their nervous system. Once they feel heard and are calm, they are much more receptive to learning the right way to handle the situation. Remember, an emotionally regulated child is a ready-to-learn child!
