KG A CLASS ASSEMBLY

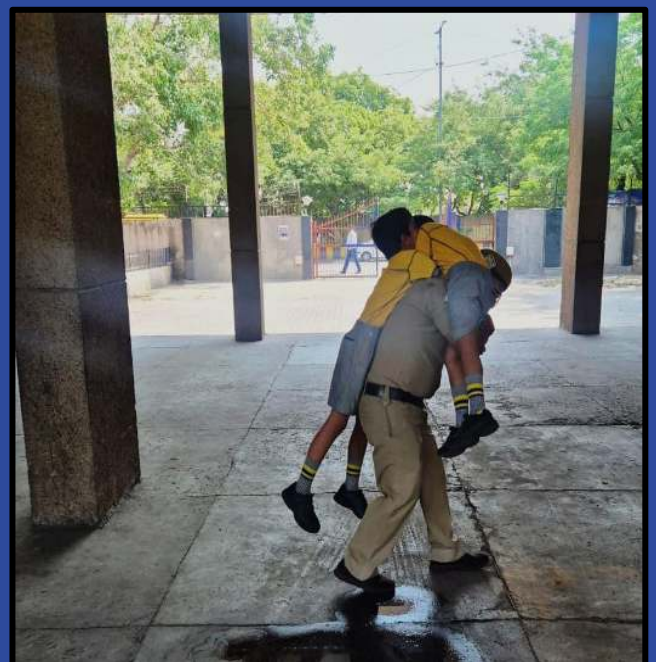
