Day & Date: Friday 03 July 2026

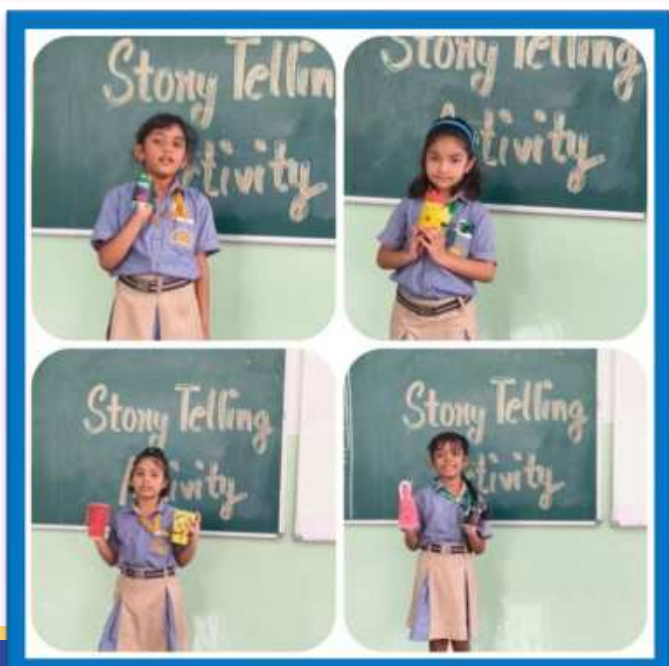
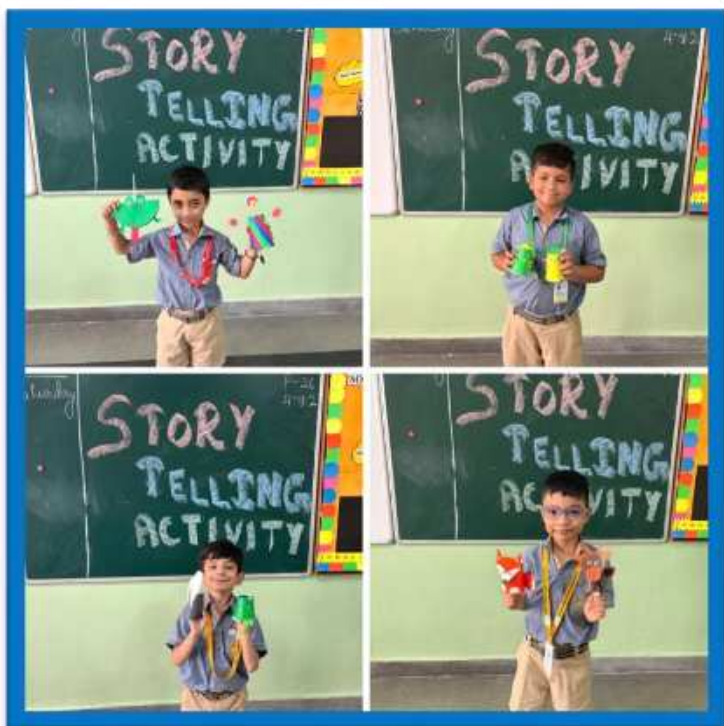

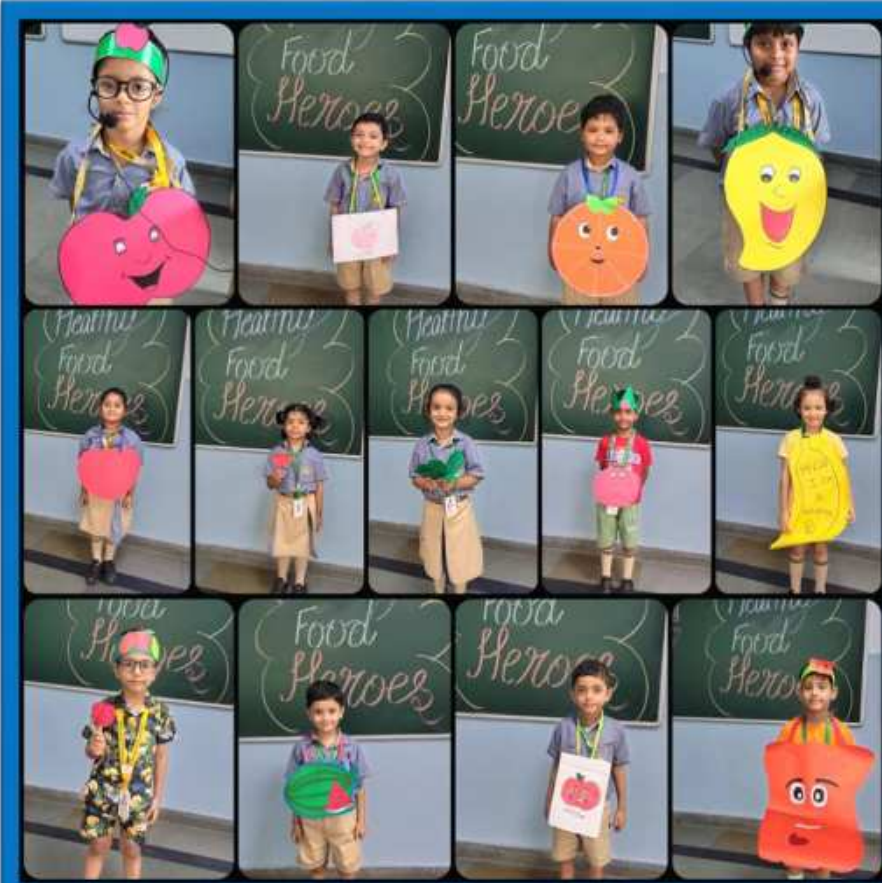


HEALTHY FOOD HEROES.....CLASS ACTIVITY

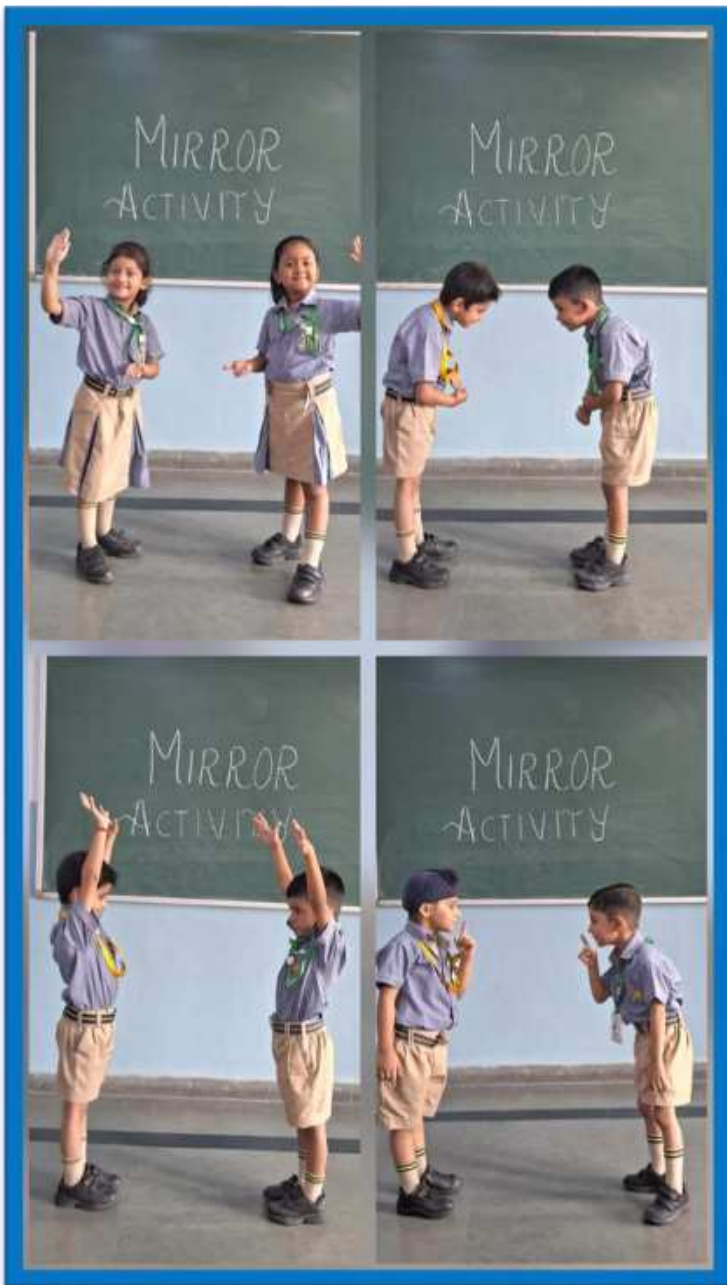




MIRROR ACTIVITY
