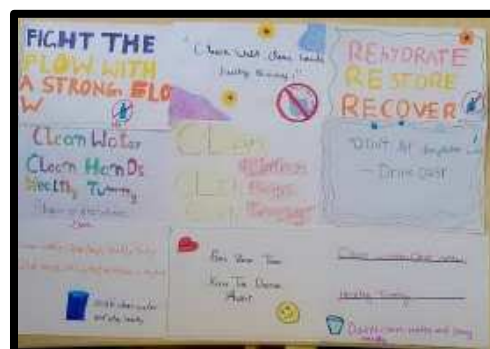


DOE Activity
