BUILDING EARLY LITERACY SKILLS

LETTER 'A a'

Day & Date: Monday, 06 July 2026 – Friday, 10 July 2026

Nursery students were introduced to the letter 'A' through the **Jolly Phonics** approach, helping them learn its sound and action. They further reinforced their understanding by tracing the letter on the sand table, followed by a **tearing and pasting** activity to develop their letter recognition and fine motor skills.



LETTER 'B b'

Day & Date: Monday, 13 July 2026 – Friday, 17 July 2026

Students were introduced to the letter '**B**' through the **Jolly Phonics** approach, enabling them to learn its sound and action. They reinforced their understanding by tracing the letter on the sand table and enjoyed a creative **hand-printing activity** to make '**B**' says **Butterfly**, enhancing both letter recognition and fine motor skills.

Day & Date: Monday, 20 July 2026 – Friday, 24 July 2026

Students were introduced to the letter '**C**' through the **Jolly Phonics** approach, helping them learn its sound and action. They reinforced their learning by tracing the letter on the sand table and created '**C**' says **Caterpillar**' through a fun craft activity, strengthening their letter recognition and creativity.



SAFE AND UNSAFE TOUCH

Day & Date: Wednesday, 22 July 2026

Students of Classes Nursery and KG attended an awareness session on 'Safe and Unsafe Touch.' The session began with a skit presented by the class teachers, helping children understand the difference between safe and unsafe touch in a simple and child-friendly way.

Teachers used a doll to explain body safety rules and private parts. The children were guided on how to respond to unsafe situations by saying 'No,' moving away, shouting for help, and informing a trusted adult such as a parent or teacher. The session concluded with sharing the Child Helpline Number – 1098 and encouraging children to always speak up if they ever feel unsafe. As a recap, a worksheet related to it was given. It was an engaging and meaningful session that promoted body safety awareness and built confidence among the young learners.



EXPLORING NATURE AROUND US

Day & Date: Thursday, 23 July 2026

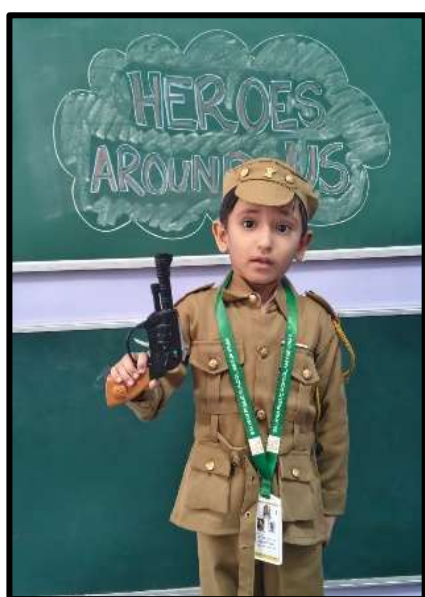
